



**Statement Concerning Off-Campus Misconduct,
Conduct Resulting in Suspension,
or Expulsion in Other School Districts**

The East Grand Rapids Public Schools District 8300 Policy series Code of Student Conduct (the “Code”) governs the behavior of students who attend East Grand Rapids Public Schools. The “Code” provides that students are prohibited from engaging in off-campus misconduct of a serious and/or criminal nature which poses a likelihood of danger to the health (physical or emotional) or welfare of students or district personnel, or which makes the presence of the student in the school disruptive to the educational process. Such conduct, if established, will make a student ineligible to enroll in and attend East Grand Rapids Public Schools.
