Breton Downs Elementary School 2008-2009 Volunteer Opportunities



ALL SCHOOL PLAY: The students of Breton will perform a play on Friday and Saturday, March 27 and 28, 2009. Mrs. Marybeth Timmer will once again direct the play, but will need many volunteers to help with tryouts, rehearsals, costuming, scenery, etc.

ARTWORKS: Your child's artwork is transformed into creative gift items including magnets, mouse pads, note cards, t-shirts, mugs, aprons, and more. Items are delivered just in time for holiday giving. Volunteers are needed to help organize the ordering and distribution of the artwork items.

AUDIT COMMITTEE: Two or three people are needed to audit the PTA books during the summer. This is small time commitment; it should only take 2 to 3 hours. Committee members may not be the incoming or outgoing PTA officers.

BARNES & NOBLE FUNDRAISER: This is a weekend fundraiser that helps provide funding for library and classroom books. Volunteers are needed to work one hour shifts at Barnes & Noble for the weekend of the fundraiser.

BREAKFAST AT BRETON: This popular event takes place in the spring before the start of the school day. Volunteers are needed to help coordinate, set up, and clean up. It is a small time commitment that helps a large number of people.

BRETON CARNIVAL: Fast becoming the most popular event of the year, Carnival is a fun filled evening for the entire community. Many volunteers are needed to help coordinate this event, which is scheduled for Thursday, October 2, 2008. A few of the volunteer opportunities include: making posters, ticket sales, set up/clean up day of event, working one hour shifts on carnival night, serving food, baking/donating a cake, handing out prizes, and more. This is a great way to meet new families at the beginning of the school year.

BRETON WEAR: Coordinate, order, and distribute logo items and apparel for Breton students, parents, and staff.

BOX TOP \$: An easy way to raise money for the school and a fun way to get involved in the PTA. Coordinate the General Mills 'Box Tops for Education' program and organize a fall and spring event to collect box tops from the students.

CHESS CLUB: Volunteers are needed to supervise chess play during lunch periods on Monday and Wednesday. Chess Club usually takes place during the winter months and rainy days only. Knowledge of the game is not required.

CHILD CARE: Coordinate and/or assist with childcare for PTA meetings and other pre-arranged events throughout the school year. The child care provider is a paid position.

COMMUNITY SERVICE: This committee will establish new and/or continue existing community service projects that involve the student population. Currently we work with Kids Food Basket which provides 'sack dinners' for approximately 1400 students in the Grand Rapids area.

CULTURAL ARTS & SOCIAL STUDIES: The Cultural Arts & Social Studies Committee works closely with the District Cultural Arts Committee and with the Breton teachers and staff to plan and host enrichment programs.

ENTERTAINMENT BOOK: The Entertainment Book sale will be held in the fall. Volunteers are needed to distribute the books and collect them at the end of the fundraiser.

EXECUTIVE BOARD NOMINATING COMMITTEE: This committee is chaired by the past PTA President and includes a current member of the Executive Board and three or four PTA members at large. Its purpose is to recruit a slate of officers for the following school year. This is a one or two meeting commitment in early winter.

EXECUTIVE BOARD SELF NOMINATION: The PTA Executive Board is composed each year in the spring by the nominating committee. It is very helpful to this committee if they know in advance who might have an interest in serving in one of these offices. All self nominations are taken under consideration by the nominating committee. The Executive Board is a great way to have a major role in the PTA.

FIFTH GRADE FAREWELL: This committee plans an end-of-year assembly and event for the entire fifth grade class. Many volunteers are needed. Some ideas of how you could get involved are helping the principal with the fifth grade farewell assembly, coordinating a party after the farewell assembly, working on the memory book, or purchasing and/or organizing the class gift.

GARDEN COMMITTEE: This committee helps maintain the beauty of Breton Downs by planting, weeding, spreading bark, and general "sprucing up" of the area around the school. Most activity would take place in the fall and/or spring. There is also some ongoing maintenance of the courtyard during the summer.

GIFT WRAP/COOKIE DOUGH SALE: This is the PTA's major fundraiser for the year. It will take place the last two weeks in September. There are prizes and awards for the top sellers of the school. We need volunteers to tally the totals for each classroom and to help distribute the paper in early November.

HOSPITALITY: This committee supplies snacks and beverages and prepares coffee for the first day of school, monthly PTA meetings, and for other school requests. The chairperson will be responsible for assigning people to specific dates as needed.

JUNIOR GREAT BOOKS: This program provides a Book Club format for students to discuss classic, multi-cultural literature. It is available to K-5th graders, and groups meet once a week during lunch for six weeks in January and February. Volunteers are needed as "group discussion leaders". Training for group leaders is funded by the PTA.

LEGISLATION COMMITTEE: This committee consists of representation from each school, the school board, and the administration. Its goal is to understand pending state and national legislation on educational issues. Meetings are held on a monthly basis around the noon hour. Representatives are also asked to report activities back to Breton Downs PTA.

MEDIA CENTER AIDE: Volunteers are needed to work one morning or afternoon per week. Possible jobs are re-shelving books, helping with displays, occasional book repair, and getting new books/magazines ready for circulation.

PTA MEMBERSHIP: Volunteers needed to coordinate the collection and recording of membership dues and registration information for the Breton Downs PTA unit. Most of the time commitment required is in the beginning of the school year.

PTA PALS: This committee welcomes new families to Breton Downs School. Volunteers are needed to mentor (answer questions and offer support) new families. Mentors would also attend an ice cream social late summer prior to school beginning. Volunteers are also need to coordinate this program.

MOVIE NIGHT: A fun night for Breton Downs families to come to the school and enjoy a family oriented movie. Volunteers are needed to help the night of this event.

PUBLISHING CENTER: The Publishing Center produces books written by Breton Downs students in grades 1-5. Parent volunteers have the option of working on-site interviewing students and assembling books, or typing at home.

ROOM PARENTS: Two volunteers are needed in each classroom to work closely with the teacher to schedule volunteers for activities throughout the year. Plan to work the first day of school collecting money, assembling classroom phone numbers and emails lists, and assisting with sign ups for classroom parties and the Breton Carnival.

RUNNING CLUB: This club promotes exercise for Breton students. It begins in March and takes place during the morning and afternoon recess, on alternating days. Volunteers are needed to punch running lap cards, make posters and card holders (can be done at home), and cheer along the runners.

SCIENCE ALIVE: A new program to Breton Downs School, this program entails three days of hands-on presentations of live animals to all the students in the school. The presentations happen throughout the year and are determined by the teachers.

SCHOLASTIC BOOK FAIR: Volunteers are needed to assist the media specialist with the Scholastic Book Fair. Held in the spring, volunteers are needed for one-hour shifts to help students make selections and pay for books purchased. Volunteers are also needed to help the media specialist with set up and takedown.

SCHOOL PICTURES: Volunteers are needed for 2- to 3-hour shifts to assist on picture day, scheduled for September, 23, 2008. Retake pictures are November, 4 2008.

SPANISH CLASSROOM HELPERS: A couple times throughout the year, the Spanish teacher has special events or programs (fiestas, crafts, snacks, and fifth grade market). Volunteers assist the Spanish teacher during these events.

STAFF APPRECIATION: Showcase your culinary skills! This committee arranges various meals to show appreciation to our Breton staff throughout the year. Volunteers provide food during fall and spring conferences, the holiday breakfast, and the staff appreciation luncheon in May. If you don't like to cook, you may always volunteer to help purchase items or help set up and/or clean up for the event. You may sign up for as many events as you wish.

SUNSHINE: This is a committee that helps Breton families in their time of need (severe illness, injury, death in the family). Volunteers may be asked to provide a meal, car pool, help with errands, etc., as needed. The committee will try to help any Breton family who asks for help.

VARIETY SHOW: The Breton Downs Variety Show is a special event that highlights the many talents of our children. The show will take place during the second semester of the 2008-2009 school year. A coordinator is needed for this event. Volunteers assist the students during practices, perform technical assistance, create scenery, and coordinate the candy and flower sale.

YEARBOOK: If you enjoy photography or creative memories, your talents could enhance the school yearbook. Volunteers work with 4th and 5th grade students for an eight-week period learning basic journalism, photography, and marketing. Photographers are also needed to take and submit pictures to the yearbook committee.
