East Grand Rapids Public Schools

- Resident
- School of Choice (SOC) - K, 1, 2 - Open until June 1
- Release from Resident District (12th grade only)
- Employment in the District
- Tuition Enrollment Program (TEP)

Pathways to Enrollment at EGRPS

1 RESIDE IN THE DISTRICT

- With one's parent(s) in an EGR home owned by one's parent(s)
- With one's parent(s) in an EGR home one's parent(s) rent
- With one's parent(s) in an EGR home owned by a relative of one's parent(s)
(Requires signed affidavit)
- With one's legal guardian in an EGR home owned/rented by the legal guardian
- Reside means to "rest one's head" the majority of the time

Pathways to Enrollment at EGRPS

2 ENTER THROUGH THE SCHOOL OF CHOICE PROGRAM *(SOC)*

- Number of openings at each grade level approved by BOE in February/March
- Applications are accepted in SOC application window - Open until June 1, 2020
- Siblings of students enrolled in the district receive priority
- Random draw for remaining openings
- Historically, openings tend to be at K-2
- Process coordinated through Kent Intermediate School District

Pathways to Enrollment at EGRPS

3 SEEK A “RELEASE” FROM THE DISTRICT IN WHICH THE STUDENT RESIDES


- Only available to juniors in their 2nd semester and seniors - *(County-wide Agreement)*
- May be available for others under extremely unusual circumstances
- Must be approved by supts. of both districts
- Process initiated by parent at their district of residency

4 BE EMPLOYED BY THE DISTRICT

- Children of employees may enroll in the district
- Employee must work for the district 10 hours or more per week
- Excludes coaches

Pathways to Enrollment at EGRPS

5 TUITION ENROLLMENT PROGRAM (TEP)

- Application process from April - August
- Eligibility Requirements 
- Annual renewal - review to ensure student continues to meet eligibility requirements
- 20-21 Tuition Rate: \$10,743
- EGRPS seeks a “release” from students resident district on an annual basis
 - If approved by resident district then student pays difference between their resident district’s foundation allowance and \$10,743
 - If denied by resident district then student pays the full tuition rate

- ❑ Grades 6th - 10th
- ❑ 3.0 GPA in Core Subjects
- ❑ Proficient on M-STEP or other Standardized Assessment(s)
- ❑ Clean Discipline record
 - ❑ No academic misconduct
 - ❑ No suspensions
 - ❑ No expulsions
 - ❑ No crimes or misdemeanors

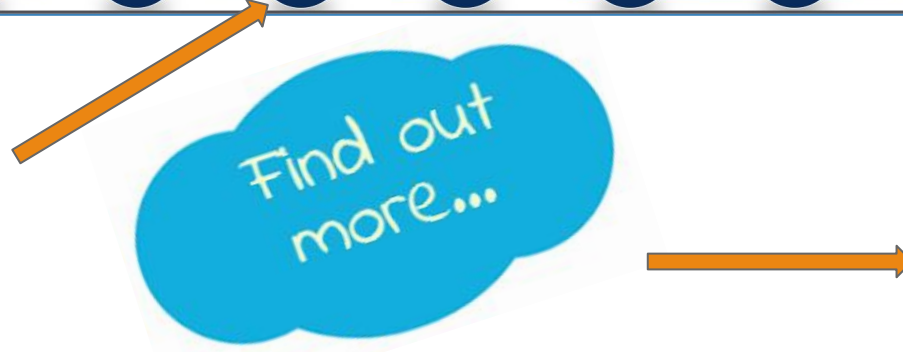
